Law enforcement agencies across Florida are being challenged to do more with less. This is certainly the case for the Leesburg Police Department. Our budget has been cut to the bone and every acquisition is evaluated for cost versus need. That's why I am pleased we purchased the Computer Voice Stress Analyzer (CVSA II) from the NITV.

Several years ago our department purchased a VSA made by one of your competitors. We became increasingly dissatisfied with that system and, in fact, our detectives had lost complete confidence in it.
